

# Cruises on the Sundays River

## Colchester, Eastern Cape, South Africa

The Sundays River runs alongside the Addo Elephant Park and into the Indian Ocean. It is bordered by one of the greatest Dune fields in the Southern Hemisphere.



It is the principal fish breeding Estuary in the Eastern Cape and has over 40 different species of birds, including the rare Fish Eagle, and the Gigantic Goliath Heron.

The river banks host a variety of wild life including Bush Buck, Kudu and Vervet Monkeys.

### Selection of River Tours

- A. To the Sand Dunes and the River Mouth. Duration 3 Hours R350-00 per person Snacks and Refreshments included. +/- 20 Kms**

Climb the highest sand dunes and view the largest dune field in South Africa, and 40km of un-spoilt natural beaches. Share the beach with Penguins, Seals and other sea life.



- B. Trip up river to Bird natural habitats. Duration 4 hours R500-00 per person Snacks and Refreshments included. +/- 40 Kms**



Observe the majestic Fish Eagles, rare Goliath Herons, and a variety of Water Birds. Also Leguans – (Water Monitors). Traverse fish natural breeding grounds. View wild animals such as Kudu , monkeys Jackals and the shy Rooi Kat.



**C. Day Trip** Duration 5 – 6 hours. A combination of both of the above includes Refreshments and lunch R600-00 per person +/- 50 Kms



**D.Sundowner on the River cruise.** Duration 3 hours R400-00 per person Includes Finger Supper and Refreshments. Return after nightfall. Experience the river by night.



Minimum 2 people, maximum 4 adults. Early morning Sunrise cruises by arrangement.
